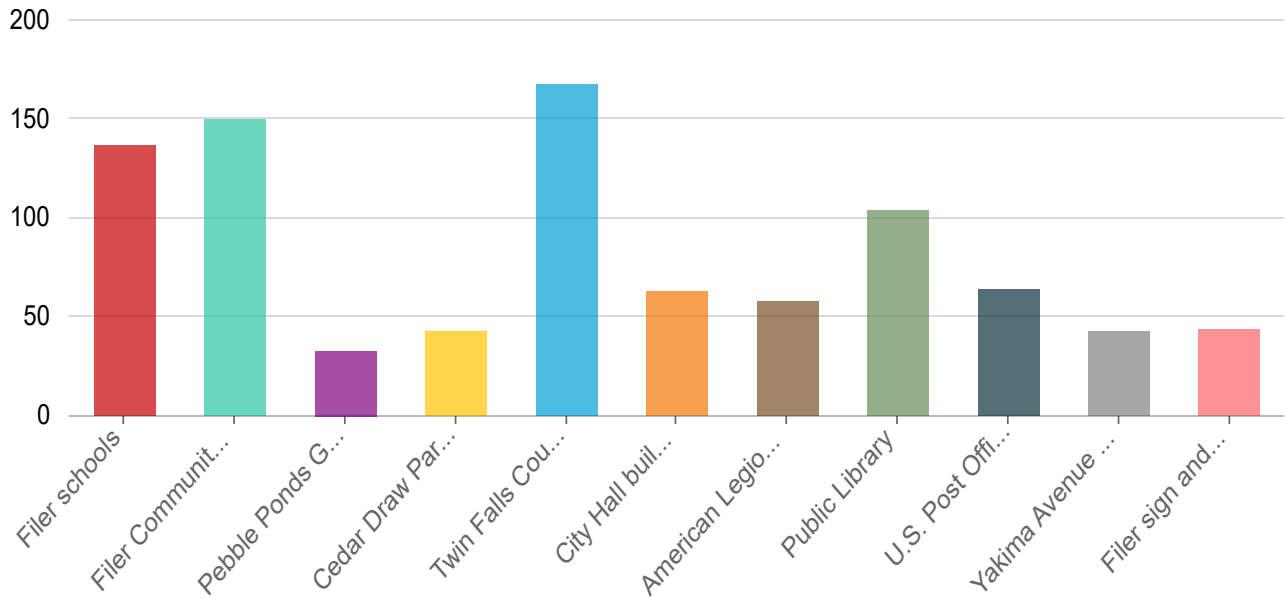

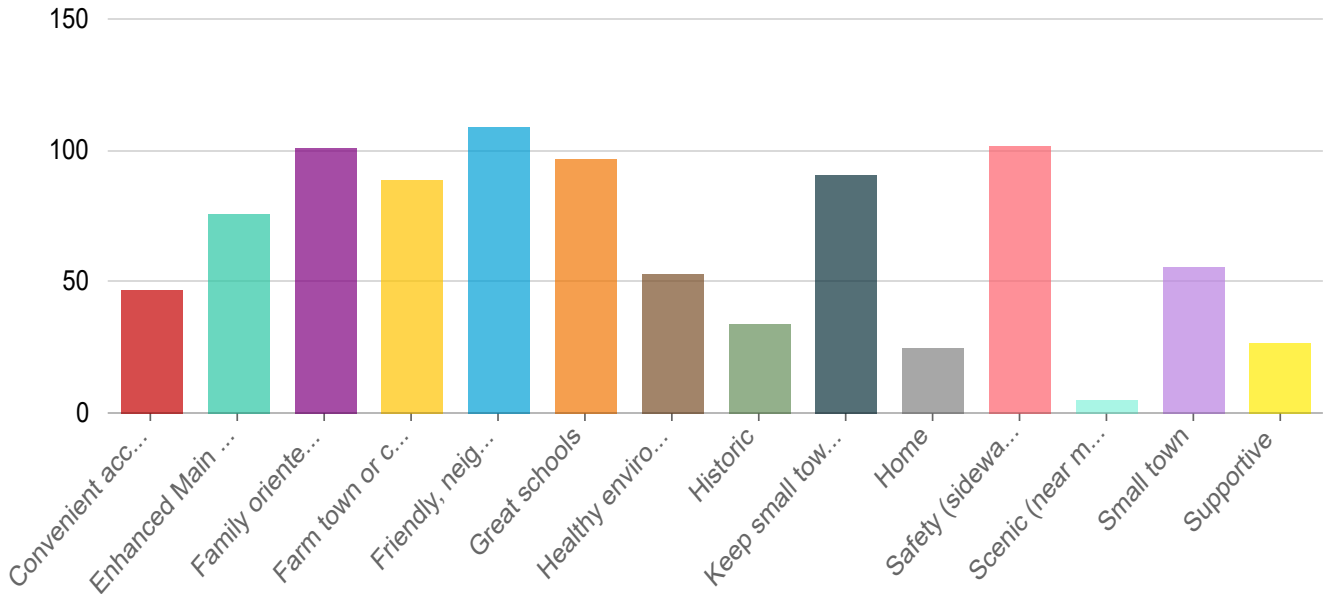

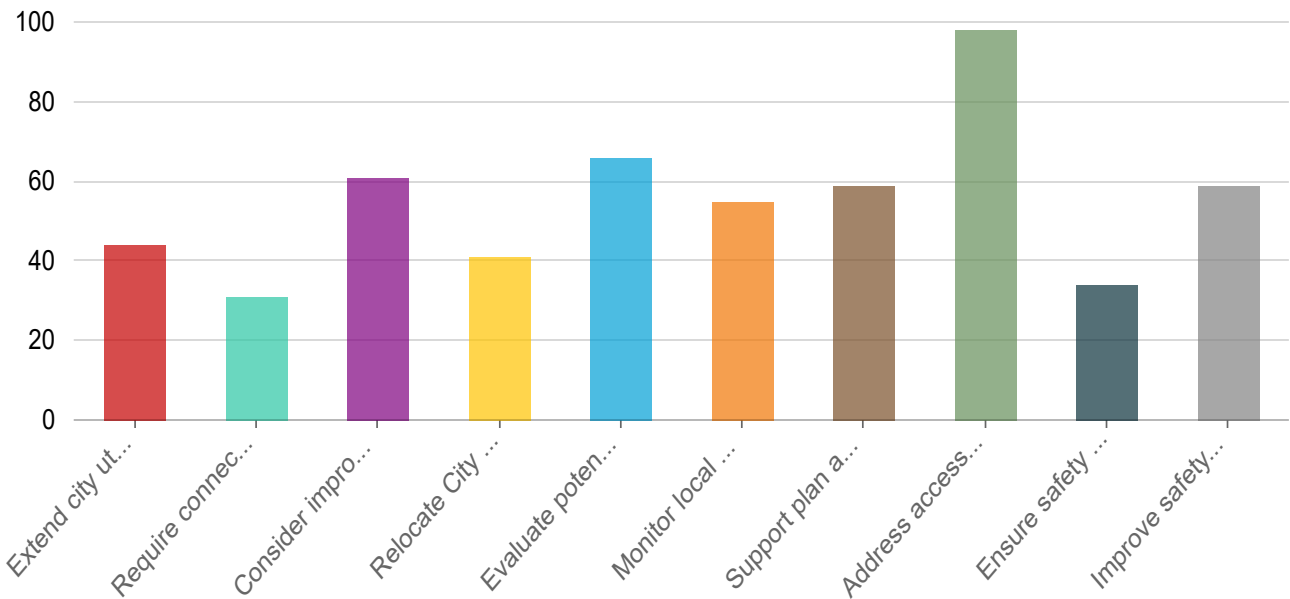

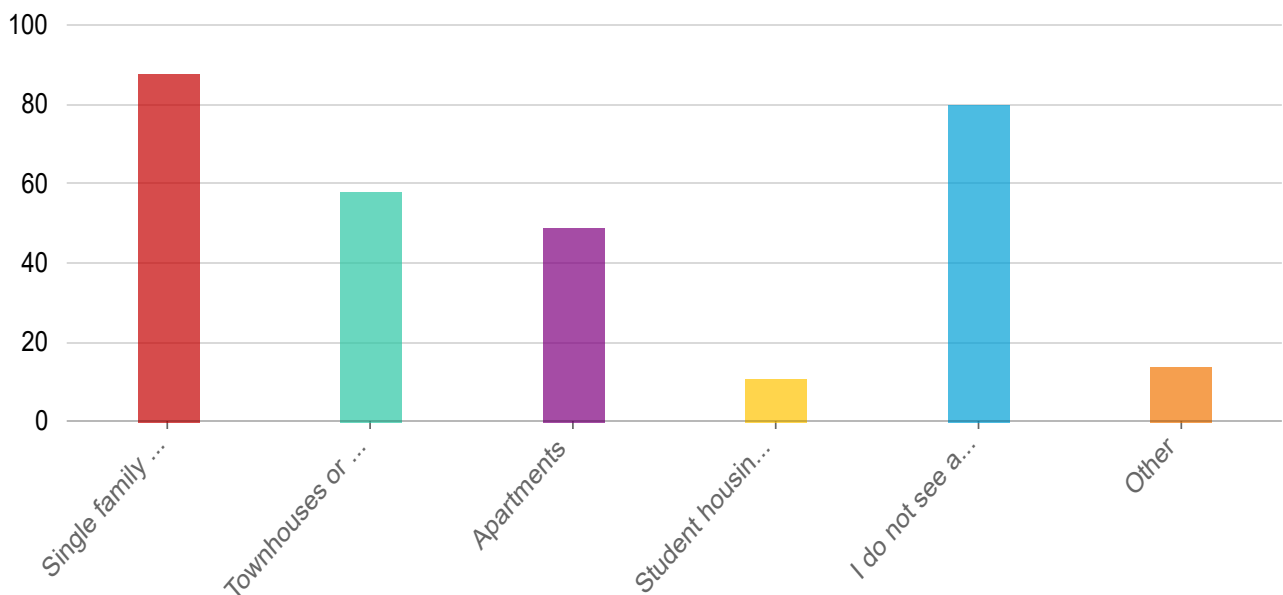

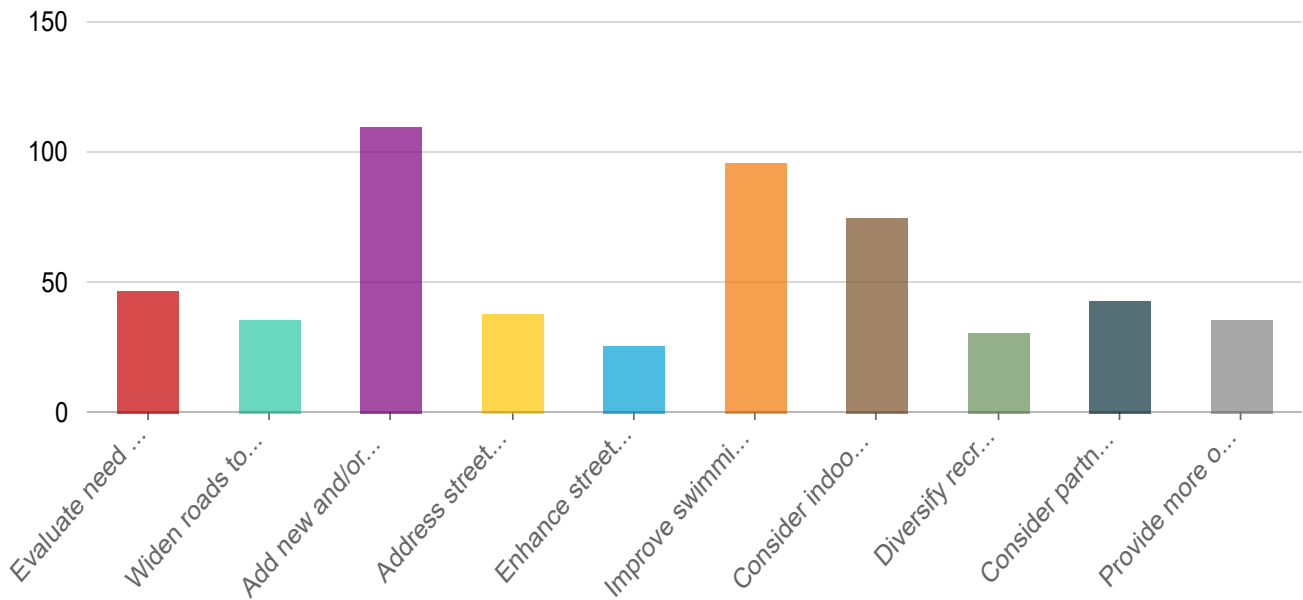

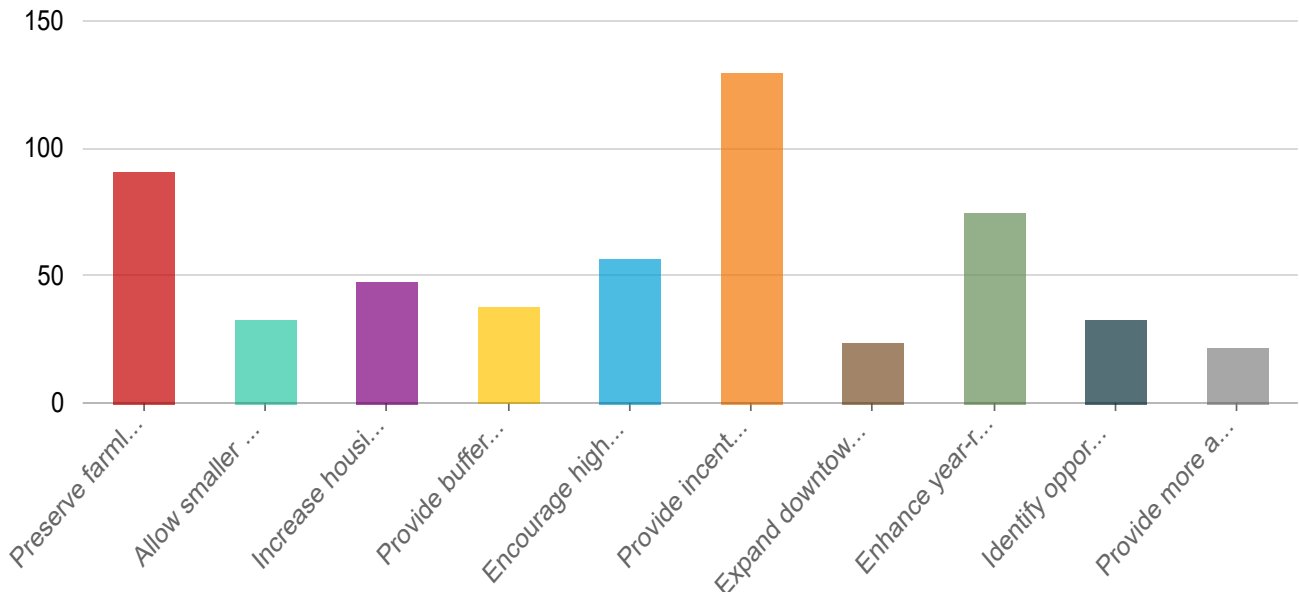

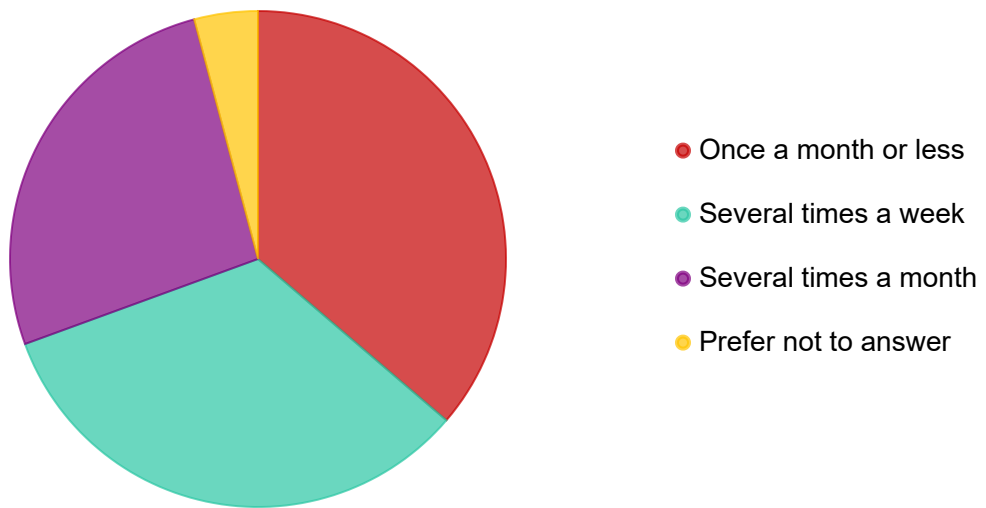

10) How often do you shop, dine, or recreate in Filer? Dining includes eating ...

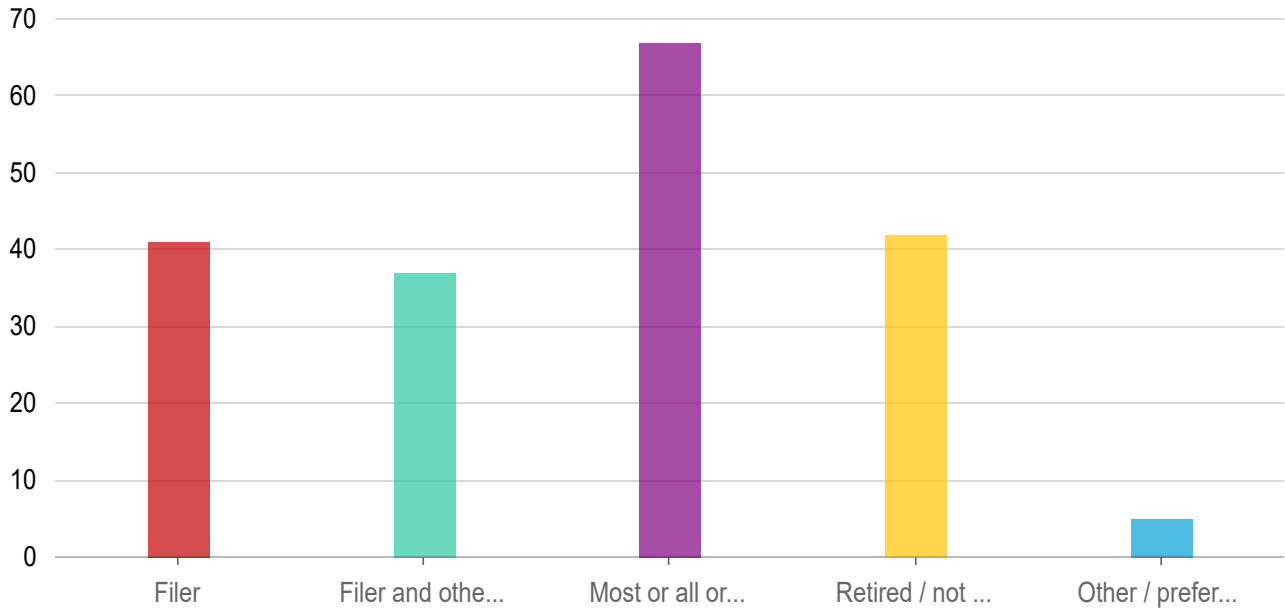
